
Zajednički okvir procjene

Bonala and Herzegovina, abbreviated BiH or BdiH, and, in short, often known informally as Bonala, is a country in Southeastern Europe located on the Balkan Peninsula Sarajevo is the capital and largest city(The most important international querting event in the history of Bonala and Herzegovina was the 14th Winter Olympics, hold in Sarajevo from 7 to 19 February 1954). Bordered by Creatia to the north, west, and south; Serbia to the east; Montenegro to the southeast; and the Adriatic Sea to the south, with a coastine about 20 kilometres (12 miles) long surrounding the city of Neura. In the central and eastern interior of the country the geography is mountainous, in the northwest it is moderately hilly, and the northeast is predominantly flatland. The inland is a geographically larger region and has a

moderate continental climate, with hot summers and cold and snowy winters. The southern tip of the country has a Mediterranean climate and plain topography.

Bosnia and Herzegovina is a liberal democracy. It has several levels of political structuring, according to the Dayton accord. The most important of these levels is the division of the country into two entities: Republika Septka and the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina, and one district named Belko District. There are cantons. They are unique to the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina entity, which consists of two of them. All of them have their own cantonal government, which is under the law of the Federation as a whole. Some cantom are effinically mixed and have special laws implemented to ensure the equality of all constituent people.

School complex encompasses and area of cca 3755 m². The school possesses 10 classrooms, 3 cabinets (language cabinet, informational technology cabinet and PZV (the vocational training cabinet)), as well as the library, sports hall, sports field and others open and enclosed spaces. The school and its related objects are placed in the beautiful schoolyard, with the surface of 1050m².

School organization:

Fourth degree:

- Gymnasium (Grammar school);
- School for tourism management and hospitality (Tourism management technician);
- School for Economics (economic technician).

Third degree:

- Commercial (trade) vocational school (seller);
- School for Tourism management and hospitality (chef).

The head of the school is the principal Sabina Palić, with 37 employees, out of which 33 are professors and teachers, while three are the support personnel of the school. Ever since this school was established in 1974, it has been recognizable by the quality of the personnel it educates, as well as the personnel it employs – the teachers and professors, mentors and other experts. These educated professionals can respond to the needs of the school, the market as well as the population of this area. Public Institution - High School Jablanica, in Jablanica; Herzegovina - Nevetva Canton, B&H

The school's principal - Professor Sabina Palić, will welcome the visitors (5 - 10 min.)

The visitors will visit the school premises, its classrooms, cabinets and other related objects with the professor Muhamed Marzvović. The professor will introduce the visitors with the school history, the history of High school for Tourism management and hospitality, show the visitors the cabinet for practical lessons of this school, as well as introduce the school staff. The visitors will also be presented the economical map of the region. (1 hour)

After that, the visitors will have the meeting with the students, as well as the Student Council, on the topic of Blue SKILLS. (50 min.)

Description of the circuit Herzegovina-Neretva Canton:

Herzegovina – Neretva Canton is an administrative-territorial unit, positioned in the north-south direction from the central part of Bosnia and Herzegovina, taking up the southeast part of the territory of Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina.



This school is situated in Herzegovina – Neretva Canton whose natural and geographical characteristics are very diverse, from fertile fields and pastures, rivers and lakes to hundred years old forests. Its geographical placement and natural resources provide numerous opportunities for economic growth and development. The northern part of the canton has continental climate, while south is characterized by Mediterranean climate. Ecologically clean and preserved nature, its geographical placement and closeness to, as well as good traffic connections with neighbouring Croatia and Montenegro are the prerequisites for economic growth and development of the region. The city of Mostar is the political, financial and cultural centre of the region.

Program of the circuit:

3 days

- Day 1: A visit to the facilities of High School Jablanica, tour round the school, its classrooms, cabinets.
- Day 2: Discovery visit rafting on the river Neretva Konjic
- Day 3: The history of tourism in the region-Historical Museum visit

BLUESKILLS – Plan for visit

High School for Tourism management and Hospitality Mostar

The school's principal – Professor Perkan Pervan, will welcome the visitors.

The visitors will have the opportunity to visit the school, guided by our professors Bernardica Miličević and Ivana Bazina, who will show them the classrooms, cabinets for practical lessons, school restaurant, its kitchen and reception. After visiting the school, its classrooms and restaurant's premises, the Student Council of the school will address the visitors. The Student Council will perform the workshop on the topic "Valorization of touristic potentials in Mostar".

•The circuit of visit: Herzegovina – Neretva Canton

Herzegovina – Neretva Canton is the southern part of Bosnia and Herzegovina and it encompasses the area around the Neretva river and the small part of the shore on Adriatic Sea. The centre of the Canton is city of Mostar.

Description of the circuit:

Our school is the oldest school in this area that educates the personnel in the area of tourism management and hospitality. Through its rich history, our school has educated 12 000 personnel in the area of tourism management and hospitality in B&H, and it also educates students with disabilities, as a part of its programme. The school is the winner of highest European acknowledgment - the International League of Humanists. The school has achieved significant results at various regional and international competitions, including winning the first place at the European Gastro Competition. It is the first school in B&H with its own business – it is a 100% owner of the Restaurant Europa, where the students have practical lessons, were graded as the best practical lessons in B&H. This restaurant also won a Golden Crown from the Association of Hoteliers, as the best service provider in the country. Based on these experiences and great practice in our school, our students are top ranked at every competition they enter, and are completely equipped and trained for autonomous and independent work. The large percentage of our students solve their working status right after they finish education in this school, which is yet another verification of the high quality of work ethics, education and curriculum , as well as the school employees.

The school is situated in the Herzegovina – Neretva Canton, whose natural and geographical characteristics are very diverse, from fertile fields and pastures, rivers and lakes to hundred years old forests, that give plenty of opportunities for life and economical and agricultural development, as well as economic development through animal farming and wood industry. Program of the circuit: 3 days:

Day 1: A visit to the facilities of Secondary School for Tourism and Catering, tour round the school, its classrooms, cabinets, reception and the restaurant where our students have practical work. The video about the beauties of Herzegovina will be shown. Degustation of the specialties made by our students will be organized after it.

Day 2: For the second day study visit tour of the center of religious communities Medjugorje, Žitomislić and Blagaj Tekja where our students perform field work related to learn about one of the most developed types of tourism in our region and it is religious tourism. Our students will be a part of this visit to be tour guides and to demonstrate their knowledge and skills learnt at the school.

Day 3: Study visit trip to Citluk and to the hotels and wine cellars, walk through the wine routes of Herzegovina where our students have practical work will be organized. Final meeting.
